WestEd is recruiting programs, teachers, and caregivers who serve infants (0-12 months) for an interrater study. The purpose of the study is to **explore how two different people complete the DRDP (2015) for the same child**. This study is supported by the California Department of Education, Early Education Support Division (EESD).

Teachers that typically complete the DRDP (primary raters) will share 3 children (0-12 months) with a secondary rater.

Secondary raters will be asked to:

- ◆ Complete the DRDP for the 3 children (0-12 months) shared by a primary rater

Primary and secondary raters, each will be asked to:

- ◆ Complete a survey (15-20 minutes)

Benefits of Participation

- ◆ Contribute to the development and improvement of the DRDP (2015)
- ◆ Up to \$100 to participating programs
- ◆ Up to \$45 for each secondary rater (\$15 per completed secondary assessment per child)

Requirements for Participation

- ◆ Programs that currently use or have used the DRDP instrument in the past
- ◆ **Secondary raters** can be teachers, assistant teachers, caregivers, program administrators, or people who are not the typical teacher/caregiver but know the children well
- ◆ Teachers/caregivers that know each other's children can serve as **secondary raters** for each other
- ◆ Program administration supports teachers' participation in the study

Participation slots available for programs that have or anticipate enrolling infants 0-12 months. Space is limited.
