Video Example: Teacher and Child Reading Transcript

Teacher: SSSS, ssss, what's that? That's an (makes an S in the air with her finger) S.

Elias: Look my letter like this one on the end (points to the last e in the word *leche* on the rug).

Teacher: That's the "s", but is that the same sound as the "h"?

Elias: No

Teacher: That's different. Let's go to the next page are you ready? "I" is for ink bottle, right in rabbit's way. "J" is for jumping, but not high enough. He didn't jump high enough. So what's going to happen to the ink bottle?

Boy: It's broken. (makes a motion with his hand to show falling over)

Teacher: It's broken. It's going to fall over. "K" is for kk kicking over.

Boy: and Kevin

Teacher: and Kevin. Kicking Kevin? That would be terrible.

Elias: That would be terrible if I kick Kevin in the face.

Teacher: It would be terrible, you would never do that.

Elias: If I punch him in the face that would be bad.

Teacher: That would be terrible.

Elias: (turns to Kevin and puts his arm around him) I wouldn't do that ok?

Teacher: You wouldn't do that. "L" is for leaking all over the floor. Do we know any "L" words?
