Video Example: Dramatic Play

Transcript

Boy: I want to hear it (takes stethoscope).

Adult: Well, I asked Joanna if she'd like to hear it before, let's see what she says before we take

them away from her. Would you like to hear it?

Joanna: (shakes head no)

Adult: She says no, so now you can listen to it. Can we listen to your chest (says to Joanna)?

Joanna: Um hmm (nods head yes).

Adult: OK. Jose, can you sit on the chair? On your bottom? (gestures to chair)

Girl: You have to do this (gestures off camera). Do that so Jose could hear your heart.

Boy: I hear it.

Adult: What did you hear?

Boy: Like roadrunner.

Adult: Roadrunner?

Girl: Let me see. (puts on stethoscope and listens) It's like dun dun, dun dun.

Boy: No, I say roadrunner.

Boy: (listening with stethoscope) Like food.

Adult: Sounds like food? What kind of food is inside Joanna?

Boy: Like pepperoni...pizza....juice

Adult: Pepperoni? (turns to Joanna) Did you eat pepperoni?

Joanna: (nods yes)

Boy: Juice

Adult: I need to hear this. Can I hear it? (places stethoscope on Joanna's ears and she listens)

Joanna: (nods yes)

Adult: (places stethoscope on Joanna's ears then listens and leans into to Joanna and whispers something to her) Do you want to listen?

Joanna: (nods yes)

Transcript

Adult: Who do you want to hear? Me? Alexandra?

Joanna: (points to adult)

Adults: Want to hear mine?

Joanna: (nods yes)

Adult: Alexandra can you hold this one? It is easier if you do it. (The end of the stethoscope is

placed on adult's heart while Joanna is listening.)

Joanna: I hear it.

Adult: What do you hear?

Joanna: Your heart.

Adult: A heart? You mean I don't have....

Girl: Do you want to hear mine? (places stethoscope on her ears)

Joanna: (nods yes)
